

Christie's Critters Purchase Agreement/Health Guarantee

Thank you for deciding to purchase one of our puppies. We want to make this a stress free enjoyable experience for you. Please feel free to email me or text me with any questions or concerns that you might have along the way. We will keep you up to date with information about your puppy as it grows until it is time for your puppy to go to its new home. This contract is written for the protection of both the breeder and the buyer. However, it is primarily written to protect the health and general well-being of the puppy.

Purchase Agreement

1. Please read the health guarantee completely before putting a deposit on a puppy. By putting a deposit on a puppy, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions within this contract.
2. We require a deposit in order to hold the puppy of your choice (will go toward price of the puppy). The deposit can be accepted through the following methods: Cash, Square Invoice (Credit Card), Facebook Transfer, Paypal, or money order.
3. This deposit is non-refundable, unless there is a problem with the health of your puppy or otherwise agreed upon. In that case, the buyer will have their choice of a full refund or of transferring that deposit toward another puppy.
4. If for any reason the buyer must rehome the dog at any point, he/she will return the dog to Christie's Critters.

****Please be certain that you are ready for the time commitment and financial responsibility of a puppy prior to putting a deposit on one. ****

Health Guarantee

5. It will be up to us, the breeders, to decide when the puppy will be ready to go to its new home. Usually at the age of 8 weeks, depending on the weight of the puppy and how easily it is weaned from the mother. We will not, under any circumstances, let the puppy leave before it is ready.
6. The puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of sale unless specified by the breeder.
7. The puppy will be up-to-date on shots and worming at the time of pickup. It is very important that you continue the vaccinations and worming. Please do not expose your puppy to other dogs that are not vaccinated until he/she has completed the entire vaccination schedule - around 16-20 weeks old.
8. The puppy will have been vet checked and deemed in good health at the time of sale.
9. The buyer, at their own expense will need to have the puppy examined by a licensed vet within 72 hours of receiving the puppy for the health guarantee to be honored.
10. Documentation must be sent to the breeder within five days in order for the Health Guarantee to be honored.
11. If within 72 hours, a licensed vet finds the puppy to be unhealthy or unfit for sale, the puppy may be returned for a full refund - provided the puppy has not been injured or neglected. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming the puppy "unhealthy for purchase".
12. This guarantee does not cover any health issues caused by neglect or injury from the buyer.
13. This guarantee does not include minor illnesses and health issues such as colds, allergies, luxating patellas, internal or external parasites or umbilical hernias. However, the breeder will disclose any known illnesses or health issues prior to the sale. To help avoid these minor problems, use the recommended food found via the links below.
14. The breeder cannot assume responsibility for this puppy after 72 hours of the sale. It is the responsibility of the buyer to care for the puppy properly and keep it free from harm. Please remember that your puppy must be treated with great care and protected from danger.
15. The breeder assumes no responsibility for any medical expenses incurred after the sale.
16. The breeder assumes no responsibility for training difficulties or behavior problems. Although we begin training with the puppies at a very young age, it is the buyer's responsibility to continue training the puppy and correct behavioral problems.
17. The breeder does not guarantee size. We will give the buyer the weight of the puppy's parents and the weight of other puppies out of that mating. We can give the buyer an educated guess as to full grown weight, but there are too many variables besides genetics.
18. The breeder does not guarantee fertility or ability to place in shows. The puppy is strictly sold as a TOP QUALITY PET.
19. The breeder is not responsible for puppies which develop hypoglycemia after the puppy is in the new owner's possession.

20. Optional 10 Year Guarantee: Pomeranians can live anywhere from 10-20 years if given proper nutrition. We are willing to guarantee at least 10 years of life if the dog is exclusively fed Life's Abundance Dog Food and treats. This includes congenital defects. There is no additional cost to this 10-Year Guarantee and the food and treats cost less per month than other quality dog foods. If you stop feeding Life's Abundance for any reason, only the 10-Year Guarantee is void. The rest of this contract will remain in force. If the puppy passes from a life-threatening illness within ten years, the buyer will provide a copy of the necropsy report with the microchip number included in order to receive another puppy of the same breed and value when one becomes available. _____ Initials
21. If for any reason I am unable to keep the puppy, I agree to return the puppy to Christie's Critters and not place the puppy in another home unless given permission by the breeder. If puppy is returned within the first 30 days, only half of the purchase price will be refunded after the puppy has been placed in his/her new home. The other half will cover the cost of re-advertisement and keeping the puppy current on vaccinations and worming until the puppy is placed in his/her new home. If puppy is returned after the 30 days no money will be refunded. _____ Initials

What you need to provide:

22. The purchase of a crate. A 24-inch crate will be sufficient for all mature Pomeranians. Your puppy will have started crate training, and we recommend you continue. We recommend the MidWest Ovation Single Door Dog Crate.
23. Schedule a puppy exam with your veterinarian so he is able to see puppy within 3 business days after pick-up. This will allow you to establish care and have a vet examine your new family member. It is best to make that appointment now and have it on the calendar before pick-up. Many vets don't have openings for several weeks out. The puppy won't be ready for their next shots at that time, so this will only be an exam. Do not let them give your puppy a shot until 3-4 weeks after their last shots.
24. Whether you choose the 10-year guarantee or not, we recommend you purchase your first order of products from Life's Abundance at least one week prior to picking up your puppy. We recommend an 8 lb. bag of All Life's Stages dog food, 16 oz Tasty Rewards (for training) a pack of 6-inch Buffalo Bully Sticks (for chewing) a 18 oz bag of Antioxidant Health Bars (for anxiety and health), shampoo, bath fresh mist, and biodeodorizing cleaner. This gives you everything you will need for your new puppy for around \$100 if you purchase the Healthy Start Pack. You will not need to purchase all of these items every 7-weeks. You will also be able to adjust the timing of the autoship schedule as needed. 25. Purchase a food and water dish of your choice.
26. You will be given a harness, and leash at time of pick up. Although they are not leash broke at 8 weeks, this will allow you to get puppy home safely. Once you get puppy home, you can measure him for a collar of your choice if you so desire. It's always fun to shop! Remember, NEVER use a leash on the collar, only on the harness.

All paperwork will be ready for you as well as medical records and a copy of the signed agreement.

SHIPPING OUT OF STATE: For those of you having your puppy delivered, that will happen at 10 weeks. The airport must be specified and the cost of the flight included in the deposit.
